

• Total sites assessed: 66

• Year 2: 42.6% survival

• Year 5: 39.5% survival

# Post Plant Tending by Landowners

Good vs. Bad



#### Good Tending

- Vegetation around trees mowed
- Very easy to assess and assess survival



No Tending

- 2 metres (6 feet) tall, thick grass
- Trees difficult to find even if they had survived under the vegetation

## **Conservation Lands – Protected Spaces**

#### **Canada's Protected and Conserved Areas Database (CPCAD)**



- Supported by Environment Climate Change Canada (100% cost recovery)
- Peer reviewed by Ministry of Environment Conservation & Parks
- Focus on protected areas
- 136 properties accepted
- Nearly 12,000 acres
- Update published in 2025



#### **Two Creeks Forest Restoration**



- Site preparation for wetland pond construction
- Dead ash tree removal along sections of trail

#### Wetland Restoration



SNC 53 wetland project, Nation Municipality

- Planted 200 potted trees and shrubs
- Wood duck boxes and turtle basking logs to be installed this winter



#### **Invasive Species Monitoring**



Common Reed at 7 Ponds South Dundas

- Eastern Ontario Phragmites Management Area Working Group
- Regional collaboration to map invasive Phragmites
- Develop a prioritization framework for management actions



## Water Quality Monitoring



Benthic invertebrate sampling on a tributary of the St. Lawrence River South Dundas

- 40 sites sampled through the Ontario Benthos Biomonitoring Network
- Data supports watershed report cards and watershed plans



## Monitoring – Provincial Groundwater Monitoring Network

- PGMN Fall sampling is complete 14 wells were sampled
- Exceedance Protocol Sodium

#### Water and Erosion Control




Chesterville Dam – Chesterville, Ontario





- 11 caliper trees planted at Jessup's Falls



#### **Stop Orders**



Permit compliance inspection Municipality of South Dundas

- New ability for CAs as of April 1, 2024
  - An officer may make an order requiring a person to stop engaging in an activity if there are reasonable grounds to believe:
    - 1) the person is contravening or will contravene the CA Act or the conditions of a permit;
    - the activity has caused, is causing, or is likely to cause significant damage; and
    - 3) the order will reduce the damage
- SNC Officers have issued two Stop Orders to date
