



Canadian Navigable Waters Act

South Nation Conservation hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Common Project Search (online registry) pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* described herein and its description.

Pursuant to paragraph 4(1) of the said Act,

South Nation Conservation has deposited a notification of minor work in accordance with the requirements set out on the *External Submission Site*, on the online Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry number **15098**, a description of the following work:

repairs consisting of minor concrete removals, installation of reinforcing steel mesh and formwork, and pouring of new concrete at

- the Casselman Dam stoplog sluiceway by way of a cofferdam, which also includes stoplog gain and stoplog replacement
- the Casselman Dam weir downstream face

in, on, over, under, though or across the **South Nation River**,

at the Casselman Dam adjacent to High Falls Park on Riviere Nation Road. N, Casselman, Ontario, located in front of Con. 6 PT Lot 10.
